





**ON FRIDAY 25<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER at 12 Noon here in St Barnabas Church:** There will be a short Vigil Service conducted by the Revd Phil Brooks to mark the start of this year's **SIXTEEN DAYS OF ACTIVISM AGAINST GENDER BASED VIOLENCE**. One in three women across the World will be affected by domestic violence at some point in their lives. All are welcome.

**THE 5 O'CLOCK CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS EVE NATIVITY SERVICE** at St Barnabas will once again this year include some 'Wriggly Nativity' songs as a part of the service.
