







THIS MONTH'S CHARITY OF THE MONTH is "MERU" (MEDICAL ENGINEERING RESEARCH UNIT): Originally based at Queen Mary's Hospital in Carshalton, the charity designs and manufactures specialised equipment for children and young people with disabilities. Some children have disabilities so complex that no available equipment meets their needs. At MERU, they use their design and engineering skills to custom-make exactly what each child needs to achieve their goals.
