St Nicholas Church and Coronavirus (21)

(letter from Revd Frances, 8 November 2020)

Dear Sisters & Brothers,

Although not unexpected, it is a blow that we are in lockdown again for at least a few weeks. As part of the new arrangements, church services have once again been suspended until further notice.

This time we are allowed to keep the church open for individual prayer, so we will stick to our current opening hours:
Thursday 10.30am – 12.30pm

Do call in if your exercise route takes you past St Nicholas. It will be lovely to see you and it will give you the opportunity to offer a prayer for the nation as the Archbishops have asked us to. Whether at church or at home, please pray that people will find strength and hope in these difficult times: pray for those who are vulnerable or afraid, for themselves or the people they love. Give thanks for those who work in our medical and support services and pray that those who are researching prevention and cure will soon succeed.

Please let me know if there is anything we can do to support you during lockdown and continue to pray for and keep in touch with each other.

The Dean of Southwark, The Very Revd Andrew Nunn, has written a prayer for the second lockdown which you might wish to use:

Lord Jesus,
who entered the locked room
and made yourself known to your friends;
be with us in this lockdown
that we may be aware of your presence
and know your blessing upon us. **Amen.**

Do be assured of my prayers for you.
May almighty God keep us safe in body, mind and spirit as we ask him in Jesus' name.

Archbishops' Call to Prayer

The Archbishops have called for 28 days of prayer starting from Thursday 5 November and continuing until the end of the period of lockdown. We are invited to prayer throughout this period but particularly to prayer together, wherever we are, at 6pm each day.

The Archbishops have asked that we focus on prayer and service.

We are asked to particularly focus our prayers on those who are isolated and alone, seeking God's wisdom as to how we can best serve them during this second lockdown.

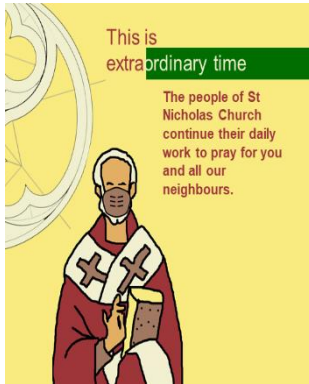
Love one another
